



Georgian Ghervasie, Commissioner General for the representation of the Romanian Government concerning participation in Expo Milan 2015, was appointed under the Prime Minister's Decision no. 214/2013.

From July 2012 until October 2013 he was counselor for promoting the business environment at the Prime-Minister's Chancellery; between 2009 and 2012 he held the position of Director General for communication and public relations at the Senate of Romania. Previously, between 2002-2004, he was Governmental expert, advisor to the Secretary General of the Romanian Government and coordinated the Inter-ministerial Council for promoting Romania's Image Abroad.

Between 1995-2000 he worked for several Italian companies, between 2000-2002 coordinated the activity of a printing house, from 2004 to 2006 worked in the Italian Trade Commission at the Italian Embassy in Bucharest and since 2006 until 2009, he led a private project management company.

In 1996 he graduated from the Faculty of International Economic Relations at the University of Economic Studies in Bucharest, and in 2004 he received a Ph. D. in Economics with the thesis "The Establishment and Development of Specialized National Institutions promoting Romanian International Economic Relations".

The courses attended include: training in foreign trade at Trieste, Ancona, Pescara, Bari and Rome; Italian Monetary Policy – Faculty of Economics and Trade, Perugia; Quality Manager (ISO) at the – European Organisation for Quality. He performed several research programs with different themes and earned awards at sessions organized by academic institutions.
