### **UN Security Council Resolution 2035 (2012)**

extends the application of listing criteria to entities (para. 3), repeals the exemptions in support of the implementation of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement set forth in paragraph 7 of resolution 1591 (2005) (para. 4)

### **UN Security Council Resolution 1945 (2010)**

control on any sale or supply of arms and related materiel to Sudan not prohibited by previous resolutions

### **UN Security Council Resolution 1672 (2006)**

updates the list of targeted persons (para. 1)

### **UN Security Council Resolution 1591(2005)**

extends the arms embargo to all parties to the N'Djamena Agreement (para. 7); travel ban (para. 3, letter d); freezing of funds and economic resources (para. 3, letter e)

### **UN Security Council Resolution 1556(2004)**

embargo on arms and related material, ban on provision of certain services (para. 7 and 8)

*European Union*

**Council Decision 2011/423/CFSP concerning restrictive measures against Sudan and South Sudan and repealing Common Position 2005/411/CFSP**

embargo on arms and related material, ban on provision of certain services applicable to Sudan and South Sudan (art. 4); travel ban (art. 1); freezing of funds and economic resources (art. 3)

for the arms embargo: art. 5 of CD 2011/423/CFSP, art. 4 and 5 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 131/2004

for the restrictions on admission: art. 2, para. 2-4 of CD 2011/423/CFSP;

for the freezing of funds and economic resources: art. 3, para. 3 and 4 of CD 2011/423/CFSP; art. 3- 5 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1184/2005.
