❖ RESTRICTIVE MEASURES

1. Council Decision 2012/285/CFSP of 31 May 2012 concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies threatening the peace, security or stability of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau and repealing Decision 2012/237/CFSP – [original](#) – [consolidated version](#)

Article 1

- travel restrictions imposed on persons who:
 - are listed in the Annex to UNSCR 2048 (2012), and additional persons designated by the Security Council or by the Committee established pursuant to paragraph 9 of UNSCR 2048 (2012), in accordance with paragraph 6 of UNSCR 2048 (2012);
 - engage in or provide support for acts that threaten the peace, security or stability of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau and persons associated with them.

Article 2

- freezing of funds and economic resources belonging to, owned, held or controlled by natural or legal persons, entities or bodies engaging in or providing support for acts that threaten the peace, security or stability of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau and natural or legal persons, entities or bodies associated with them.

2. Council Regulation (EU) No 377/2012 of 3 May 2012 concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies threatening the peace, security or stability of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau – [original](#) – [consolidated version](#)

Article 2

- freezing of funds and economic resources belonging to, owned, held or controlled by natural or legal persons, entities and bodies who have been identified by the Council as either engaging in or providing support for acts that threaten the peace, security or stability of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau or being associated with such persons, entities or bodies.

❖ DEROGATIONS AND EXCEPTIONS

- from the travel restrictions – article 1, paras. (2) to (10) of Council Decision 2012/285/CFSP;
- from the freezing of funds and economic resources – article 2, paras. (3) to (5) of Council Decision 2012/285/CFSP, articles 4 to 6 of Council Regulation (EU) No 377/2012.

UN Security Council Resolution 2048 (2012)

- travel restrictions regarding persons:
 - seeking to prevent the restoration of the constitutional order or taking action that undermines stability in Guinea-Bissau, in particular those who played a leading role in the coup d'état of 12 April 2012 and who aim, through their actions, at undermining the rule of law, curtailing the primacy of civilian power and furthering impunity and instability in the country;
 - acting for or on behalf of or at the direction of or otherwise supporting or financing individuals identified in the first subparagraph.
